 - The closest airports from NDMU are Baltimore Thurgood Marshall (BWI), Ronald Reagan Washington National Airport (DCA), and Dulles International Airport (IAD).
 - Arrange transportation from the airport to the campus.

 - > Your passport
 - Our acceptance letter
 - > Your signed I-20
 - Address of your university or your place of residence in the U.S.
