Post-Baccalaureate Registered Nurse Resident

The VA Maryland Healthcare System (VAMHCS) Post-Baccalaureate Registered Nurse Residency (PBRNR) Program is a federally funded program that provides new graduate nurses with the needed training time dedicated to enhancing clinical competencies while also identifying their interests and defining their nursing career paths within the organization. The VA classifies RNs in this program as trainees, not staff nurses. Trainees receive a stipend and there is no service obligation following program completion. After program completion, residency graduates can apply for positions within the Veterans Health Administration (VHA) nationwide.

Requirements

- U.S. Citizen
- Bachelor's degree in nursing (from a CCNE or NLNAC accredited program)
- No prior experience as a registered nurse (RN)

- Graduated less than one year before program start date
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0
- Unrestricted RN license
